### **Reading: Isaiah 6:1-5**

In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of his robe filled the temple. Above him were seraphim, each with six wings: with two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. And they were calling to one another:

‘Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty;  
the whole earth is full of his glory.’

At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke.

‘Woe to me!’ I cried. ‘I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the Lord Almighty.’

### **Thinking about the reading**

In this series, we are thinking about what God is like. In the Bible it says that God is holy. What does it mean to be holy?

When we think about God, we know that he is different from us. He is much greater, so wise and good and kind.

God is also pure. He is all good. He is never horrible and never does anything bad.

And God is special. When he says something, it is really important.

So, God is different, pure and special. This is what we mean when we say God is holy.

Isaiah is a prophet who lived long before Jesus. A prophet gives messages from God to the people. He saw God in his special temple surrounded by angels who sang ‘Holy, holy, holy.’ They were saying that God is pure and special. He is holy.

Father God, we praise you because you are holy. You are different, pure and special.

Please help us to understand what it means when we say you are holy.

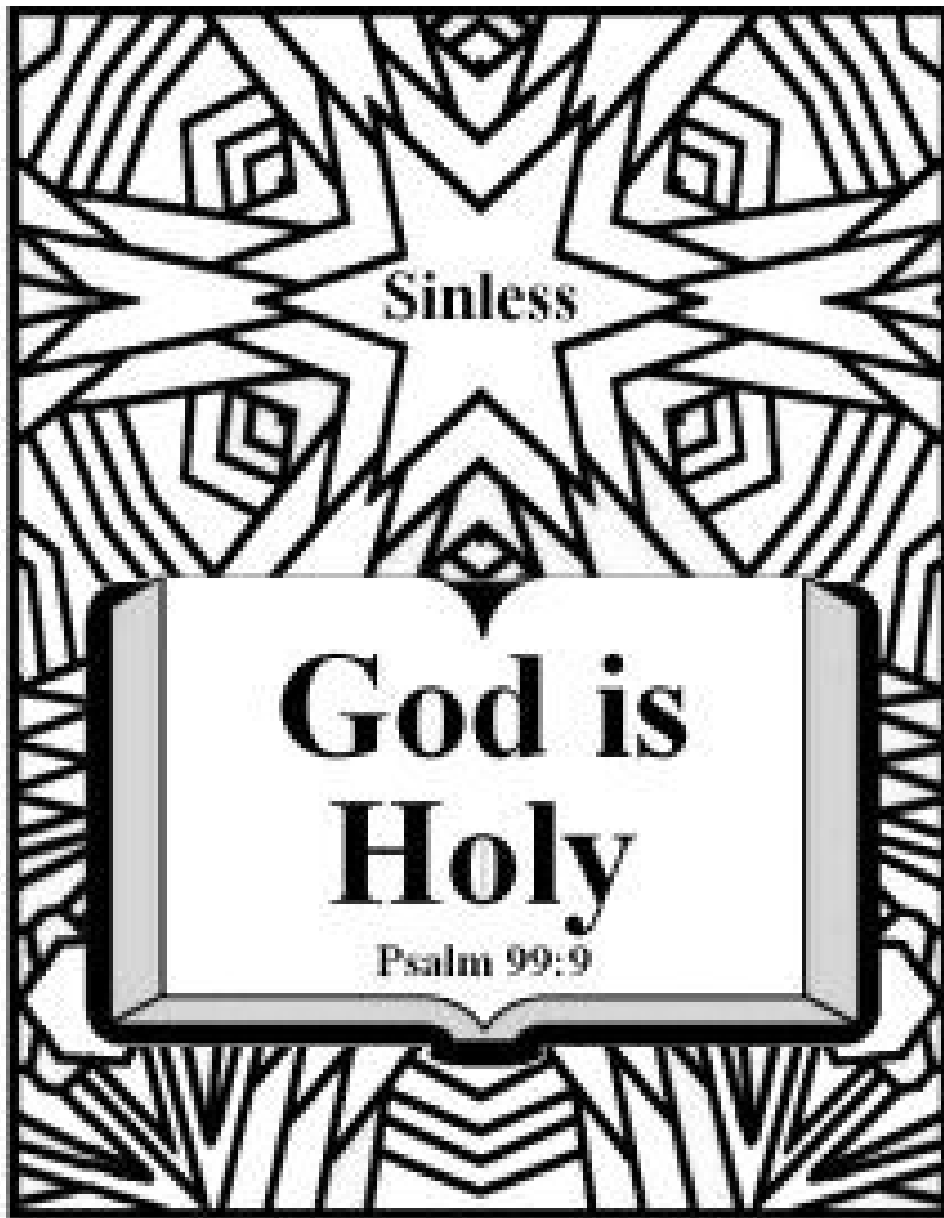
