Well that fruit is not for you. Don't eat it or you'll have to leave this beautiful place.

Narrator:

For a long time they were very happy. They enjoyed all the tasty fruit.

Have someone ready to hold up a large sheet of paper with "Then" on it, and say the word loudly as well. Perhaps get the rest to join in loudly!

THEN

At this point act out using a toy snake, the interaction between the snake and Eve. We had the snake crawling over Eve's shoulder and hissing a lot! Make sure that you emphasise:

Eve was aware of what God had said
She had a choice
She knew the outcome would not be good.
